*LB56 was passed and signed by the Governor on February 18, 2014. This law affects the county races that will appear on the 2018 primary election ballots. When only one person files for office, and no write-in affidavit is received by March 5, the race will not appear on the primary ballot. The one person filing will be declared nominated and will advance to the General election.

**Pursuant to law, where filings do not exceed two candidates for each vacancy, candidates are duly declared nominated in the Primary Election and their names will appear on the ballot for the General Election.
