BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING

April 16, 2018

The Red Willow County Board of Commissioners met in the Commissioners' Room in the courthouse on April 16, 2018, for their regular meeting. A notice of the meeting was published in the McCook Gazette and posted on the County's website. The agenda was e-mailed to each commissioner and the news media, posted on the County's website, and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

At 9:00 a.m. Chairman Earl McNutt called the meeting to order with the following members present: Earl McNutt, Steve Downer and Jacque Riener. McNutt informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

A motion was made by Riener, seconded by Downer, to approve the agenda as corrected. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Riener.

Chairman McNutt offered the floor for Citizens' Comments. Cayla Richards was present. No comments were made.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the last meeting and the accounts payable claims.

A motion was made by Riener, seconded by Downer, to approve the following items on the consent agenda: 1) minutes from the previous Board of Commissioners and Board of Equalization meetings, 2) appoint Jim Coady and Mike Daffer to Planning Commission, terms to expire April 30, 2021; appoint Phil Bamesberger to Zoning Adjustment Board, term to expire April 30, 2021. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Riener.

A motion was made by Downer, seconded by Riener, to enter into a public hearing at 9:34 a.m. to receive comments on a Conditional Use Permit for Randel Farms. Roll Call: Ayes: Downer, Riener, McNutt. Zoning Administrator Kristi Korell was present for the public hearing. A motion was made by Downer, seconded by Riener, to adjourn from the public hearing at 9:51 a.m. Roll Call: Ayes: Downer, Riener, McNutt. A motion was made by Riener, seconded by Downer, to approve the Conditional Use Permit for Randel Farms LTD & Randel Family Trust to use an existing pivot as well as install a new pivot to apply waste water from Kingdom Dairy. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Riener.

The following correspondence was reviewed and placed on file: approved Zoning Permit for Justin Harris, 2) Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement – Red Willow County Compliance.

The following report was reviewed and placed on file: Clerk's Monthly Revenue Report.
