BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MEETINGS

November 4, 2019

The Red Willow County Board of Commissioners and the Board of Equalization met in the Commissioners' Room in the courthouse on November 4, 2019. A notice of the meetings was published in the McCook Gazette and posted on the County's website. The combined agenda was e-mailed to each commissioner and the news media, posted on the County's website, and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

At 9:00 a.m. Chairman Earl McNutt called the Board of Commissioners meeting to order with the following members present: Earl McNutt, Steve Downer and Cayla Richards. McNutt informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Downer, to approve the agendas as presented. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Richards.

Chairman McNutt offered the floor for citizens' comments. Lynda Ruppert and Jacque Riener were present. Lynda Ruppert thanked the Commissioners for the gravel that was put on her roads. Jacque Riener talked to the Commissioners about The Big Give McCook. If anyone gives to Hillcrest on Thursday November 7, 2019 the money will be matched by .50 up to \$3,400.00.

Chairman McNutt recessed the Commissioners' meeting at 9:15 a.m. for the Board of Equalization.

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MEETING:

Chairman Steve Downer called the Board of Equalization meeting to order at 9:15 a.m. with the following members present: Steve Downer, Cayla Richards and Earl McNutt. Downer informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

Sue Wesch, Treasurer, presented tax roll corrections for the Tax Year 2018. A motion was made by Richards, seconded by McNutt, to approve Tax Roll Correction No. 27 which decreased the tax rolls by \$227.46, Tax Roll Correction No. 28 which decreased the tax rolls by \$15,339.82, Tax Roll Correction No. 29 which decreased the tax rolls by \$13,489.68, Tax Roll Correction No. 30 which decreased the tax rolls by \$1,246.96, Tax Roll Correction No. 31 which decreased the tax rolls by \$1,172.52, Tax Roll Correction No. 32 which decreased the tax rolls by \$1,968.30, Tax Roll Correction No. 33 which decreased the tax rolls by \$3,302.72, Tax Roll Correction No. 34 which increased the tax rolls by \$51.22 and Tax Roll Correction No. 35 which increased the tax rolls by \$314.46. Roll call: Ayes: Downer, Richards, McNutt.

Chairman Downer adjourned the Board of Equalization meeting at 9:21 a.m.

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING: (Reconvened)

Chairman McNutt reconvened the Board of Commissioners meeting at 9:21 a.m.

Wesch also presented a report of Collected and Uncollected Distress Warrants. There were 52 distress warrants issued for a total of \$42,313.61.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting, and the miscellaneous accounts payable claims.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Downer to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. Roll Call: Ayes: Downer, Richards. Abstain: McNutt

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Downer, to approve the remaining items on the consent agenda: 2) miscellaneous accounts payable claims in the amount of \$5,471.64, 3) authorize Chairman's signature on Permit to Move Oversized Load for Ward Craft Homes. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Richards.

Myra Stoney, Director of the Southwest Nebraska Public Health Department and Kathie Skeen joined the Board to present their annual report.
