BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MEETINGS

December 2, 2019

The Red Willow County Board of Commissioners and the Board of Equalization met in the Commissioners' Room in the courthouse on December 2, 2019. A notice of the meetings was published in the McCook Gazette and posted on the County's website. The combined agenda was e-mailed to each commissioner and the news media, posted on the County's website, and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

At 9:00 a.m. Chairman Earl McNutt called the Board of Commissioners meeting to order with the following members present: Earl McNutt, Steve Downer and Cayla Richards. McNutt informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Downer, to approve the agendas as presented. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Richards.

Chairman McNutt offered the floor for citizens' comments. No one was present.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting, and the miscellaneous accounts payable claims.

A motion was made by Downer, seconded by Richards, to approve the following items on the consent agenda: 1) minutes from the previous Board of Commissioners meeting, 2) miscellaneous accounts payable claims in the amount of \$42,776.38. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Richards.

Chairman McNutt recessed the Commissioners' meeting at 9:15 a.m. for the Board of Equalization.

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MEETING:

Chairman Steve Downer called the Board of Equalization meeting to order at 9:15 a.m. with the following members present: Steve Downer, Cayla Richards and Earl McNutt. Downer informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

Sue Wesch, Treasurer, presented six tax roll corrections for the Tax Year 2019. A motion was made by McNutt, seconded by Richards, to approve Tax Roll Correction No. 1 which increased the tax rolls by \$1.76, Tax Roll Correction No. 2 which decreased the tax rolls by \$7,350.98, Tax Roll Correction No. 3 which increased the tax rolls by \$2,155.30, Tax Roll Correction No. 4 which increased the tax rolls by \$346.70, Tax Roll Correction No. 5 which increased the tax rolls by \$4,454.30 and Tax Roll Correction No. 6 which increased the tax rolls by \$394.66. Roll call: Ayes: Downer, Richards, McNutt.

Assessor Kristi Korell joined the Board along with Beth Crick and Randy Bauer. Crick wished to protest the denial of her mother's Homestead Exemption.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by McNutt, to approve the Homestead Exemption since Crick provided evidence showing that the transfer did not occur until August 16, 2019. Roll call: Ayes: Downer, Richards, McNutt.

Chairman Downer adjourned the Board of Equalization meeting at 9:30 a.m.

Chairman McNutt reconvened the Board of Commissioners meeting at 9:30 a.m.

A Notice of Public Hearing from City of McCook regarding Community Development Law was reviewed and placed on file.

The following claims were allowed: Truck Town \$838.90, Regional Care Inc. \$41,937.48. Total: \$42,776.38.
