BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MEETINGS

July 20, 2020

The Red Willow County Board of Commissioners and the Board of Equalization met in the Commissioners' Room in the courthouse on July 20, 2020. A notice of the meetings was published in the McCook Gazette and posted on the County's website. The combined agenda was e-mailed to each commissioner and the news media, posted on the County's website, and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

At 9:00 a.m. Chairman Earl McNutt called the Board of Commissioners meeting to order with the following members present: Earl McNutt (via phone), Steve Downer and Cayla Richards. McNutt informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Downer, to approve the agendas as presented. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Richards.

Chairman McNutt offered the floor for citizens' comments. Todd Weimer was present to show support and appreciation for the Board.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting, and the miscellaneous accounts payable claims.

A motion was made by Downer, seconded by Richards, to approve the following items on the consent agenda: 1) minutes from the previous Board of Commissioners and Board of Equalization meetings, 2) miscellaneous accounts payable claims in the amount of \$1,389.98, 3) Vice Chairman's signature on Oversized Load Permit for Ward Craft Homes, 4) Vice Chairman's signature on County Roadway Occupancy Permit for McCook Public Power District, 5) reappoint Chuck Tines and Jan Gilbert to Planning Commission; terms to expire April 30, 2023. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Richards.

McNutt recessed the Commissioners' meeting at 9:15 a.m. for the Board of Equalization.

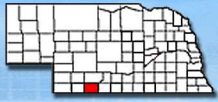
