



# Red Willow County Board Minutes



## BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MEETINGS

October 5, 2020

The Red Willow County Board of Commissioners and the Board of Equalization met in the Commissioners' Room in the courthouse on October 5, 2020. A notice of the meetings was published in the McCook Gazette and posted on the County's website. The combined agenda was e-mailed to each commissioner and the news media, posted on the County's website, and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

At 9:00 a.m. Chairman Earl McNutt called the Board of Commissioners meeting to order with the following members present: Earl McNutt, Steve Downer and Cayla Richards. McNutt informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Downer, to approve the agendas as presented. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Richards.

Chairman McNutt offered the floor for citizens' comments. No one was present.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Downer, to approve the following items on the consent agenda: 1) minutes from the previous Board of Commissioners meeting, 2) there were no accounts payable claims, 3) Chairman's signature on a Road and Bridge Contracts Report for Miller & Associates, 4) Chairman's signature on Oversized Load Permit for Williams Midwest House Movers Inc. 5) changes to Pledged Securities for County Treasurer. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Downer, Richards.

McNutt recessed the Commissioners' meeting at 9:15 a.m. for the Board of Equalization.

### BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MEETING:

Chairman Steve Downer called the Board of Equalization meeting to order at 9:15 a.m. with the following members present: Steve Downer, Cayla Richards and Earl McNutt. Downer informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

Sue Wesch, Treasurer, presented a tax roll correction for the Tax Year 2017. A motion was made by McNutt, seconded by Richards, to approve Tax Roll Correction No. 41 which increased the tax rolls by \$585.68. Roll Call: Downer, Richards, McNutt.

Kristy Korell, Assessor, presented the omitted, undervalued and overvalued property to the Board. A motion was made by Richards, seconded by McNutt, to approve the omitted, undervalued and overvalued changes presented. Roll Call: Ayes: Downer, Richards, McNutt.

Clerk Tami Teel presented levies for the following political subdivisions for which the Red Willow County Board of Equalization is empowered to levy or certify a tax levy: McCook Public Schools and Southwest Public Schools, ESU No. 15, Cities of McCook and Indianola, Villages of Bartley, Danbury and Lebanon, rural fire districts of Bartley, Beaver Valley, Indianola and Red Willow Western, cemetery districts of Danbury, Hamburg and Lebanon, Middle Republican NRD, High Plains Historical Society, and the County. A motion was made by McNutt, seconded by Richards, to levy the necessary taxes for 2020 and certify all levies as presented for said political subdivisions. Roll call: Ayes: Downer, Richards, McNutt.

Downer recessed the Board of Equalization meeting at 9:28 a.m.

McNutt reconvened the Board of Commissioners meeting at 9:28 a.m.

The Clerk of District Court's monthly revenue report was reviewed and placed on file.
