BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING

February 8, 2021

The Red Willow County Board of Commissioners met in the Commissioners' Room in the courthouse on February 8, 2021. A notice of the meeting was published in the McCook Gazette and posted on the County's website. The combined agenda was e-mailed to each commissioner and the news media, uploaded on the County's website, and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

At 9:00 a.m. Chairman Earl McNutt called the Board of Commissioners meeting to order with the following members present: Commissioners Earl McNutt, Cayla Richards and Randy Dean. McNutt informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Dean, to approve the agenda as presented. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Richards, Dean.

Chairman McNutt offered the floor for Citizens' Comments. Dawson Brunswick was present.

A motion was made by Dean, seconded by Richards, to approve the following items on the consent agenda: 1) minutes from the previous Board of Commissioners and Board of Equalization meetings, 2) accounts payable and payroll claims in the amount of \$160,103.19, 3) Pledged Securities for the County Treasurer, 4) surplus a 1985 Chevrolet ¾ ton pickup for District 1. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Richards, Dean.

Brian Langenberg met with the Board to review the Bridge Inspection Reports submitted by Miller & Associates. There was one bridge in each District that needs to have some work done on it. They discussed several actions that need to be addressed in the near future.

Sheriff Alan Kotschwar joined the Board to present two bids for a video security system for the Law Enforcement Center. The bids were received from Accurate Controls from Wisconsin in the amount of \$70,063.02 and Control Masters Inc. from Omaha in the amount of \$95,362.00.

A motion was made by Dean, seconded by Richards, to table the decision on the video security system until February 22, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. so that the Jail Administrator can be present. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Richards, Dean.

Kotschwar reported on the status of the jail and the inmates in lieu of an in-person inspection. As of 8:30 a.m. this morning they have 28 inmates. They have had too many inmates so they had to take three inmates to Curtis to be housed. They are dealing with long term sentences. Everything is going well.

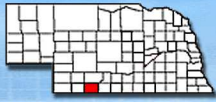
