BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING

March 1, 2021

The Red Willow County Board of Commissioners met in the Commissioners' Room in the courthouse on March 1, 2021. A notice of the meeting was published in the McCook Gazette and posted on the County's website. The combined agenda was e-mailed to each commissioner and the news media, uploaded on the County's website, and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

At 9:00 a.m. Chairman Earl McNutt called the Board of Commissioners meeting to order with the following members present: Commissioners Earl McNutt, Cayla Richards and Randy Dean. McNutt informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Dean, to approve the agenda as presented. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Richards, Dean.

Chairman McNutt offered the floor for Citizens' Comments. Stacie Sandall joined the Board to discuss HR127 which limits the Second amendment. Sandall was accompanied by Kerri Unger, April Kendall and Isaiah Kendall. They represent a group of Red Willow County citizens who would like the Commissioners to sign a resolution to preserve the Second Amendment. If HR127 were passed, it would affect everyone who owns a gun.

A motion was made by Dean, seconded by Richards, to set March 29, 2021 at 9:30 a.m. as the date and time to open grader blade bids. Roll Call: Ayes: McNutt, Richards, Dean. A Notice to Bidders is running in the Gazette, and specs are available in the Clerk's office.

The Board opened bids for a surplus 1985 pickup from District 1. They received four bids. A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Dean, to accept the high bid from Tracy Soderlund in the amount of \$1,850.00. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Richards, Dean.

A motion was made by Dean, seconded by Richards, to approve the following items on the consent agenda: 1) minutes from the previous Board of Commissioners meeting, 2) miscellaneous accounts payable in the amount of \$41,028.51. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Richards, Dean.

Notice of receipt of \$306,663.23 from NEMA Cares Act for law enforcement expenses during the COVID crisis was reviewed and placed on file.

The Sheriff's monthly revenue report, and the Community Action Partnership annual report were reviewed and placed on file.

The following claims were allowed: Regional Care Inc. \$41,028.51.

Chairman McNutt adjourned the Board of Commissioners meeting at 9:40 a.m. to March 15, 2021.
