BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING

March 15, 2021

The Red Willow County Board of Commissioners met in the Commissioners' Room in the courthouse on March 15, 2021. A notice of the meeting was published in the McCook Gazette and posted on the County's website. The combined agenda was e-mailed to each commissioner and the news media, uploaded on the County's website, and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

At 9:00 a.m. Chairman Earl McNutt called the Board of Commissioners meeting to order with the following members present: Commissioners Earl McNutt and Randy Dean. Cayla Richards was absent. McNutt informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

A motion was made by Dean, seconded by McNutt, to approve the agenda as presented. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Dean. Absent: Richards

Chairman McNutt offered the floor for Citizens' Comments. No one was present.

Sheriff Alan Kotschwar and Chief Deputy Joe Koetter joined the Board to discuss security cameras in the Courthouse. They would like to have cameras installed so they would know who was in the Courthouse and which office they went into. The cameras would possibly have audio on them that could be turned on or off. There have been three incidents that have come up during Court where cameras would have been useful. A motion was made by Dean, seconded by McNutt, to table the discussion on cameras for the Courthouse until they get more information and cost on the cameras. Roll Call: Ayes: McNutt, Dean. After reviewing the accounts payable claims, McNutt questioned two claims in which mileage would be paid to employment applicants. A motion was made by Dean, seconded by McNutt, to pull those two claims from the Extension Fund. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Dean. Absent: Richards. Clerk Teel instructed her office to adjust the totals and rerun the reports.

A motion was made by Dean, seconded by McNutt, to approve the following items on the consent agenda: 1) minutes from the previous Board of Commissioners meeting, 2) the remaining accounts payable claims in the amount of \$212,349.13, 3) sign Resolution No. 1415, Book 23, Page 4 to assure Second Amendment Rights in Red Willow County, 4) authorize Chairman's signature on County Roadway Occupancy Agreement for McCook Public Power District, 5) changes to Pledged Securities for County Treasurer, 6) certify Claims 20090121 and 20080089 totaling \$72,000 were approved and paid from Road Fund 0300; authorizes claims should have been paid from Highway Buyback Fund 0650; direct County Clerk to record Budgetary Transaction to correct error, 7) authorize Chairman's signature on Approval of Community Plan of Southwest Nebraska Juvenile Services, 8) authorize Chairman's signature on Memorandum of Understanding for Nine County Juvenile Services.
