BOARD OF EQUALIZATION MEETING

July 23, 2021

The Red Willow County Board of Equalization met in the Commissioners' Room in the courthouse on July 23, 2021. A notice of the meetings was published in the McCook Gazette and posted on the County's website. The agenda was e-mailed to each commissioner and the news media, posted on the County's website, and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

Chairman Richards called the Board of Equalization meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. for the purpose of making decisions on protests received on ag land, commercial and residential property valuations. The following members were present: Commissioners Cayla Richards, Earl McNutt, Randy Dean, Assessor Kristi Korell, and County Clerk Tami Teel.

The Board determined that all testimony had been received at the property valuation protest hearings. The Board members and Assessor Korell had viewed the properties. Discussion was had regarding each of the 17 protests and decisions were made on each one.

A motion was made by McNutt, seconded by Dean, to approve the decisions made by the Board of Equalization as stated on each individual protest form. Roll call: Ayes: Richards, McNutt, Dean.

The protests are on file in the County Clerk's Office for public inspection and the decisions will be mailed to each landowner within seven days of this date.
