BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING

September 19, 2022

The Red Willow County Board of Commissioners met in the Commissioners' Room in the courthouse on September 19, 2022. A notice of the meeting was published in the McCook Gazette and posted on the County's website. The combined agenda was e-mailed to each commissioner and the news media, uploaded on the County's website, and kept current and available to the public at the County Clerk's Office.

At 9:00 a.m. Chairman Earl McNutt called the Board of Commissioners meeting to order with the following members present: Commissioners Earl McNutt, Randy Dean and Cayla Richards. McNutt informed the public about the location of the posted Open Meetings Act.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Dean, to approve the agenda as presented. Roll call: Ayes: McNutt, Dean, Richards.

Chairman McNutt offered the floor for Citizens' Comments. Deputy County Clerk, Penny Cooper was present. Cooper talked about the ARPA funds. The issue will be on next week's agenda.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the previous meeting and the miscellaneous accounts payable claims.

A motion was made by Richards, seconded by Dean, to approve the following items on the consent agenda: 1) minutes from the previous Board of Commissioners and Board of Equalization meetings, 2) miscellaneous accounts payable claims in the amount of \$44,863.45, 3) Chairman's Signature on SSAR required by LB904.
